

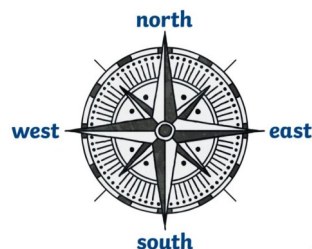


Geography in Year 1

Geographical Vocabulary

Word	Definition
Geography	The study of places and the relationships between people and their environments.
Physical Features	Natural features of the landscape, such as mountains and rivers.
Human Features	Features created by people, such as buildings and roads.
Map	A drawing representing an area of land or sea.
Compass	A tool for showing direction (north, south, east, west).
Continent	One of the main areas of land on the Earth.
Ocean	A large body of salt water that covers much of the Earth.
Capital City	The city where the government of a country is located.
Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the Earth, equally distant

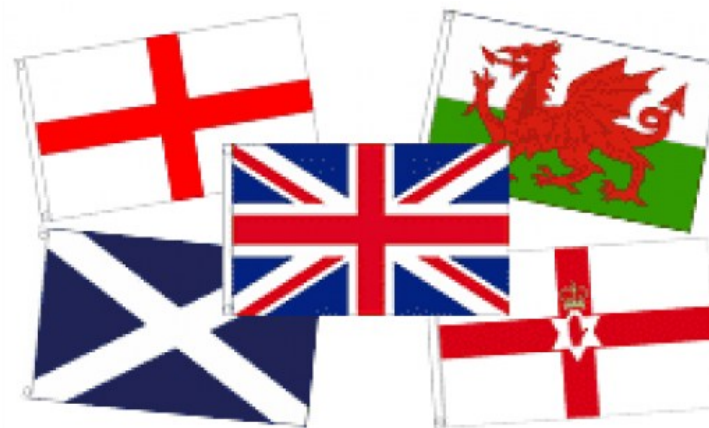
