Geographical Vocabulary	
Word	Definition
Aerial Photo	A picture taken from above, like from a plane or drone.
Physical Features	Natural features of the landscape, such as mountains and rivers.
Human Features	Features created by people, such as buildings and roads.
Landmark	An important or easily seen feature of a place, like a church or tower.
Country	A place with its own government, like the UK or Cuba.
Weather	What the air is like outside (sunny, rainy, windy, etc.).
Temperature	How hot or cold it is.
Hemisphere	Half of the Earth – Northern or Southern.
