


## **Geography in Year 3**

|-------------------------|---|
| Word                    | Definition  |
| Settlement              | A place where people live.  |
| Physical<br>Features    | Natural features of the landscape, such as mountains and rivers.  |
| Human Features          | Features created by people, such as buildings and roads.  |
| Tectonic Plates         | Pieces of Earth's crust.  |
| County                  | An area within a country which runs services such as transport, education, policing, waste management ,etc. |
| Pollination             | The process where bees transfer pollen from the male part of a flower to the female part of a flower.       |
| Conservation            | Action taken to protect a population and their eco-systems.   |
| Earthquake              | Shaking of the ground.  |

(Bee Conservation)




Bees are vital pollinators, and honey bees are the only insect that produces food (honey) that humans eat.
