



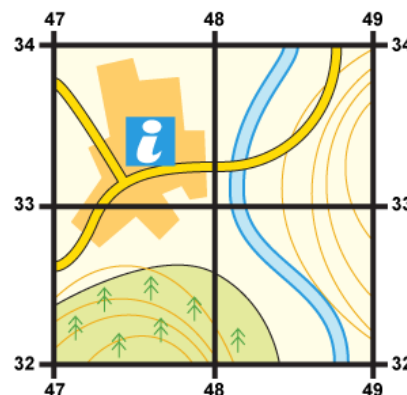

Geographical Vocabulary

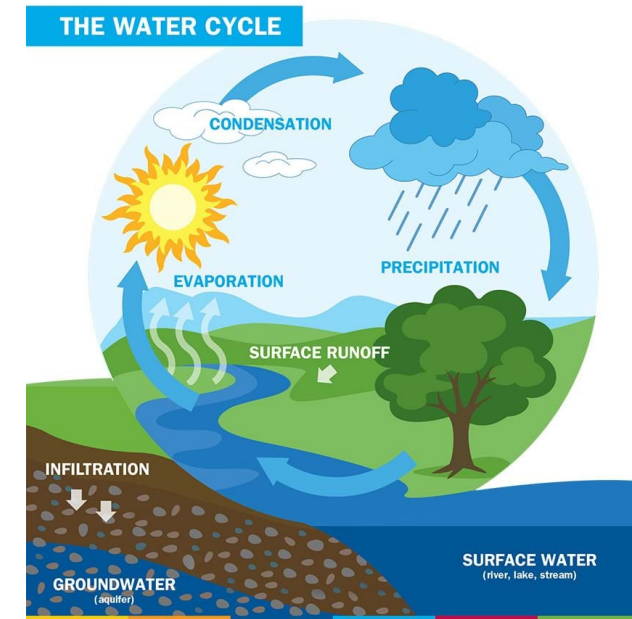
Word	Definition
Basin	A lowland area often drained by a river.
Physical Features	Natural features of the landscape, such as mountains and rivers.
Human Features	Features created by people, such as buildings and roads.
Precipitation	Rain, snow, sleet etc
Condensation	Water which collects as droplets on a cold surface when humid air is in contact with it.
Evaporation	The process where a liquid turns into a gas.
Grid Reference	Numbers used to find a square on a map.
Source	Where a river begins.

The Great Plague (OS Mapping)

To find a four-figure grid reference, you first find the bottom left corner of the square you're interested in and read the easting (horizontal) number, then the northing (vertical) number
