Geographical Vocabulary

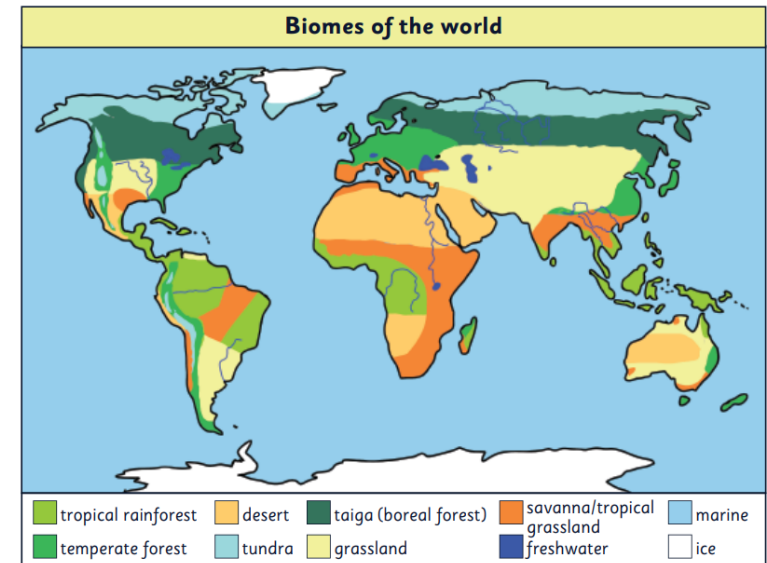
Word	Definition
Biome	A large natural area defined by climate, plants, and animals.
Physical Features	Natural features of the landscape, such as mountains and rivers.
Human Features	Features created by people, such as buildings and roads.
Food miles	The distance food travels to get to our plates.
Seasonality	When foods naturally grow best.
Interdependence	How living things rely on each other to survive.
Counties and Cities	The UK is divided into counties, each with towns and cities.
Temperate	A region or climate characterized by mild temperatures.

The UK is geographically situated in both the Northern, Eastern, and Western hemispheres. It shares a land border only with the Republic of Ireland in Northern Ireland. The UK's coastline is among the longest in Europe.

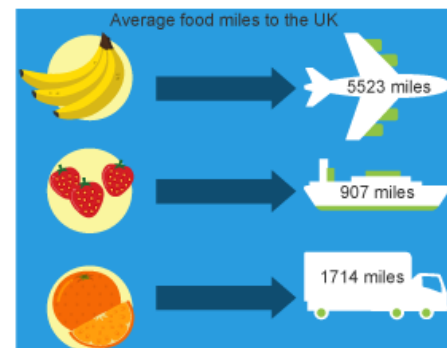


Earthlings (Biomes)
