The information below states what the children will be able to do at each stage in the programme.

Set 1 single letter sounds: a-z (except q). Set 1 special friends: sh, ch, qu, ng, nk, th, ss, ff, ll, ck

Set 2 sounds: ay, ee, igh, ow (blow), oo (zoo), oo (book), ar, or, air, ir, ou, oy

Set 3 sounds: ea, oi, a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e, aw, are, ur, er, ow (cow), ai, oa, ew, ear, ure, ire, tion, tious, cious, au, e-e, ie, ue, ph, wh, kn.



## Set 1 sounds Group A

Children in this group are learning to read the first 16 Set 1 single-letter sounds (m a s d t i n p g o c k u b f e).

They will be learning how to blend sounds into words orally.

They will be learning to blend to read words from Word time 1.1-1.3 which include sounds they already know.



Set 1 sounds Group B

Children in this group know more than the first 16 Set 1 single-letter sounds.

They will continue to learn the remaining Set 1 single-letter sounds.

They will still be learning to blend sounds into words orally.

They will still be learning to blend to read words from Word time 1.1-1.4 which include sounds they already know.

Review Set 1 sounds taught.



# Set 1 sounds Group C

Children in this group know most set 1 single-letter sounds (sounds as Group A and also | h r j x y w z v).

They can blend sounds into words orally.

They will continue to learn the remaining Set 1 single-letter sounds.

They will be learning to blend to read words from Word times 1.1-1.5 which include sounds they already know.

Review Set 1 sounds taught.



Ditty Group


Children in this group know all set 1 single-letter sounds speedily.

They can blend to read most words from Word time 1.1-1.5.

They will learn the Set 1 special friends (sh ch th nk ng qu ss ll ff ck)

They will blend to read words from Word time 1.6.

They will read Ditty Photocopy Masters 1-10.





Children in this group can read most real and alien words from Word time 1.1-1.7 reading some words speedily.

They will begin to learn the first six Set 2 sounds (ay ee igh ow oo oo(u)).

They will read words containing the Set 2 sounds.

They will read Green storybooks.

They will continue to review all Set 1 sounds.

They will continue to review all words from Word time 1.1-1.7.



#### Purple Group

Children in this group can read most real and alien words from Word time 1.1-1.7 reading many words speedily.

They will continue to learn the remaining Set 2 sounds (ar or air ir ou oy).

They will read words containing the Set 2 sounds.

(If they are confident will all Set 2 sounds and words then teach the first six Set 3 sounds and words ea oi a-e i-e o-e u-e)

They will read Purple storybooks.

They will continue to review all Set 1 sounds and Set 2 sounds already taught.

They will continue to review all words from Word time 1.1-1.7 and Set 2 sounds already taught.

Vink Group
Children in this group can read the first six Set 2 sounds speedily.
They can read most real and alien words from Word time 1.1-1.7 and words containing the first Set 2 sounds reading many words speedily.
They will continue to learn the remaining Set 2 sounds (ar or air ir ou oy).
They will read words containing the remaining Set 2 sounds. (If they are confident will all Set 2 sounds and words then teach the first six Set 3 sounds and words ea oi a- e i-e o-e u-e)
They will read Pink storybooks.
They will continue to review all Set 1 sounds and Set 2 sounds already taught.
They will continue to review all words from Word time 1.1-1.7 and Set 2 sounds already taught.



Children in this group can read Set 2 sounds speedily.


They can read most real and alien words from Word time 1.1-1.7 and words containing the first Set 2 sounds reading many words speedily.

They will learn set 3 sounds and words.

They will read Orange storybooks.

They will continue to review all Set 1 sounds and Set 2 sounds already taught.

They will continue to review all words from Word time 1.1-1.7 and Set 2 sounds already taught.



They can read most real and alien words from Word time 1.1-1.7 and words containing the first Set 2 sounds reading most words speedily.

They will learn set 3 sounds and words.

They will read Yellow storybooks.

They will continue to review all Set 2 and Set 3 sounds already taught.

They will continue to review all words containing Set 2 sounds and Set 3 sounds already taught.

Blue Group
Children can read the first six Set 3 sounds speedily (ea oi a-e i-e o-e u-e)
They can read most words containing the first six Set 3 sounds.
They can read a passage at about 60-70+ words per minute attempting to read with intonation to show comprehension.
They will learn the remaining Set 3 sounds and words.
They will read Blue storybooks.

They will review Set 2 and Set 3 sounds and words.



Children in this group know all Set 3 sounds speedily.

They can read most words containing Set 3 sounds.

They can read a passage at about 70-80+ words per minute attempting to read with intonation to show comprehension.

They will be taught to read longer words.

They will read Grey storybooks.

They will review Set 2 and Set 3 sounds and words.



Literacy and language (children no longer require the programme)

Children can read all words.

They can read a passage at 80-90+ words per minute attempting to read with intonation to show comprehension.

They will complete the Accelerated Reader Star test which will give them a ZPD range to allow them to choose their own books to read at the correct level.

### Key

Black - things a child already knows.

Blue - things to be taught.

Green - things to be reviewed.
