End of Year Expectations for Nursery

This booklet provides information for parents and carers on the end of year expectations for our nursery children and the steps we would expect for children to be school ready at the start of reception. All the objectives will be worked on throughout the year and will be the focus of direct teaching. Any extra support you can provide in helping your children to achieve these is greatly valued.

If you have any queries regarding the content of this booklet or want support in knowing how best to help your child please talk to your child's teacher.

Communication and Language

Sit and listen for a short while
Look at the person who is talking
Be confident to speak to adults
Hold a conversation with friends
Respond to own name when it is called out
Understand instructions and follow simple rules

PSHE

Feel comfortable being away from main carer
Interact with other children
Share toys and take turns
Able to wait for a turn
Know how to ask for help when needed

Physical Development

Know and name body parts
Know how and when to wash hands and blow own nose
Begin to dress independently
Put on coat and do up the zip
Put on and take own shoes off
Use the toilet independently (including wiping!)
Able to sit at a table
Eat with a knife and fork
Have a good bedtime routine so children are not tired for school
Recognise own belongings
