Impact:

More pupils have taken part in competitions including Netball, football, gymnastics, cross-country, swimming and Athletics.

Year 5/6 Netball team (boys and girls) won the first East Leicester Festival of the year in October.

We entered a Year 2 team and Year 3/4 team into the East Leicester City gymnastics competition. The Year ¾ team came second and the Year 2 team came first. As the Year 2 team won they qualified to represent East Leicester in the School Games County Final at New College but unfortunately this coincided with St Joseph's feast day Mass and so they were unable to compete. We also had the best all round gymnast in Year 2 and she received a gold medal for her individual performances.

We also entered children from Years 3-6 in the cross country competitions with 40 of our children able to take part.

The year 4-6 outdoor athletics team competed in the Leicester City competition at Saffron Lane. We won 1 bronze medal, 4 silver medals and 2 gold medals.

During 2017-18 we will receive £18,000 for PE.

During this academic year we aim to have at least 50% of our pupils participating in at least 1 after school Sport's club.

This year we have also employed a teaching assistant who is an experienced football, cricket and rugby coach. He will be supporting the delivery of PE lessons and increasing the capacity of our after school clubs.

PE resources have been purchased for both playgrounds, giving pupils more sports' focussed activities to play during lunch and dinner times. These will be refreshed each term. This will help to reduce the number of "incidents" at these times and to increase pupils' overall levels of fitness.

It is anticipated that funds will be spent on entering competitions, participating in sports' day events and transport to and from venues.

We are also currently looking at replacing our PE scheme throughout all Key Stages.
