

SCIENCE

Year 1 will be learning about what makes an animal an animal? Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, omnivores and herbivores. Group together animals according to their differences. Recognise similarities between animals.

LITERACY

Year 1 We will be writing simple sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops which can be read by ourselves and others. We will be applying phonic knowledge for reading and begin to recognise 150 high frequency words. Recite poems and rhymes by heart. Develop fluency, accuracy and confidence by re- reading books.

MATHS Year 1 will be looking at place value with in 10. Count objects and represent the numbers. Count forwards and backwards and finding one more, one less. Compare numbers and objects. We will be learning to use the addition symbol. Adding together and using number bonds to 10.

ART & DESIGN

We will record and explore ideas from first hand observations and experiment with a variety of media. This will include drawing, painting and printing.

RE Year 1 will be continuing to look at the topic Belonging. We will be learning about Judaism, we look at the story of Abraham and Moses. We will look at the Advent topic Waiting. How does it feel to have to wait? What can we do to prepare?

PE

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

We will be learning to join appropriately using glue or tape. Fold and cut paper or card, cut along straight or curved lines. Experiment with levers and sliders.
