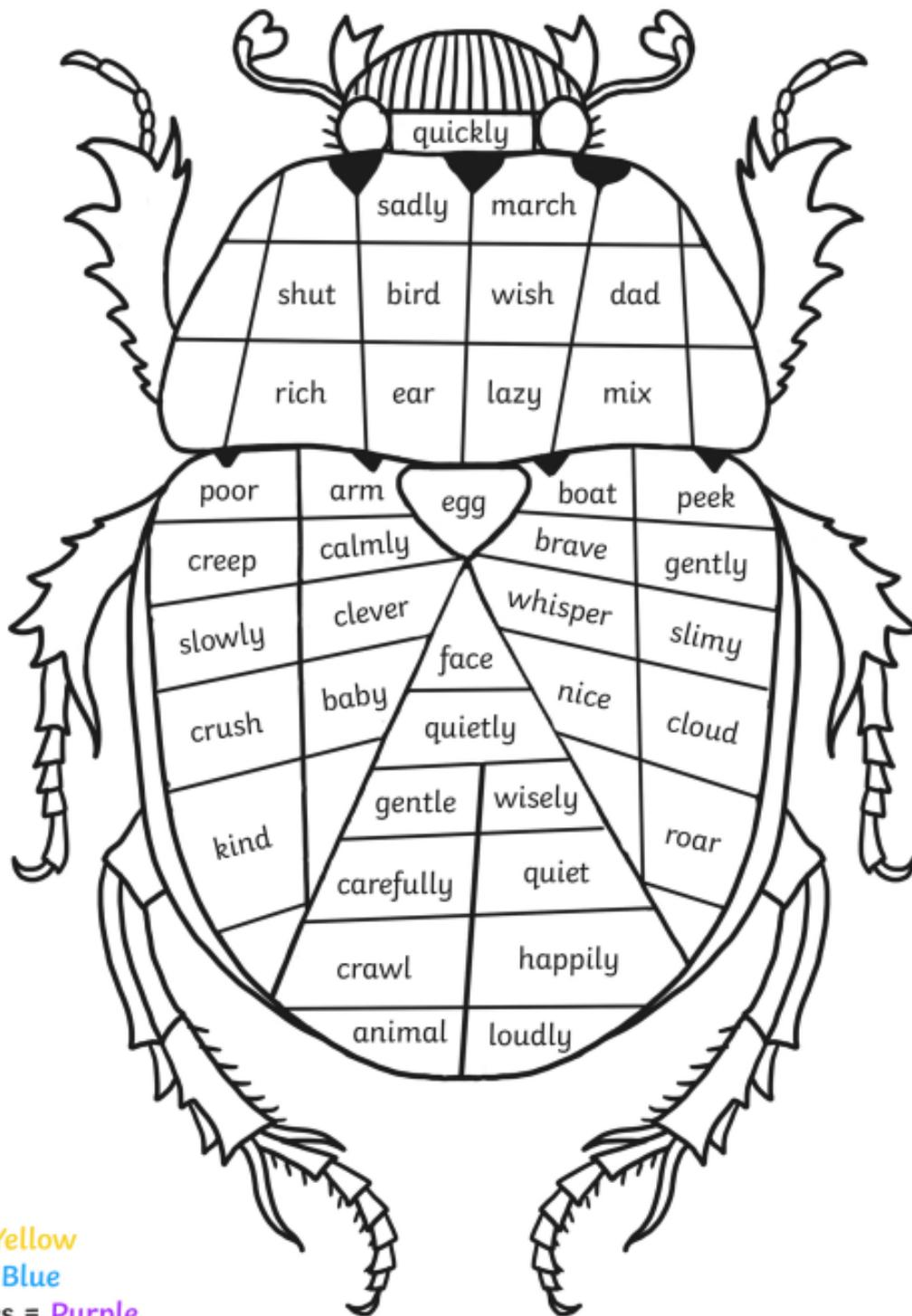

Can you identify which of these words are nouns, verbs, adverbs or adjectives using a colour code?

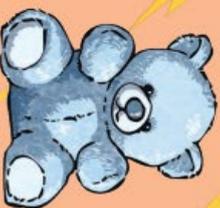


- Verbs = Yellow
