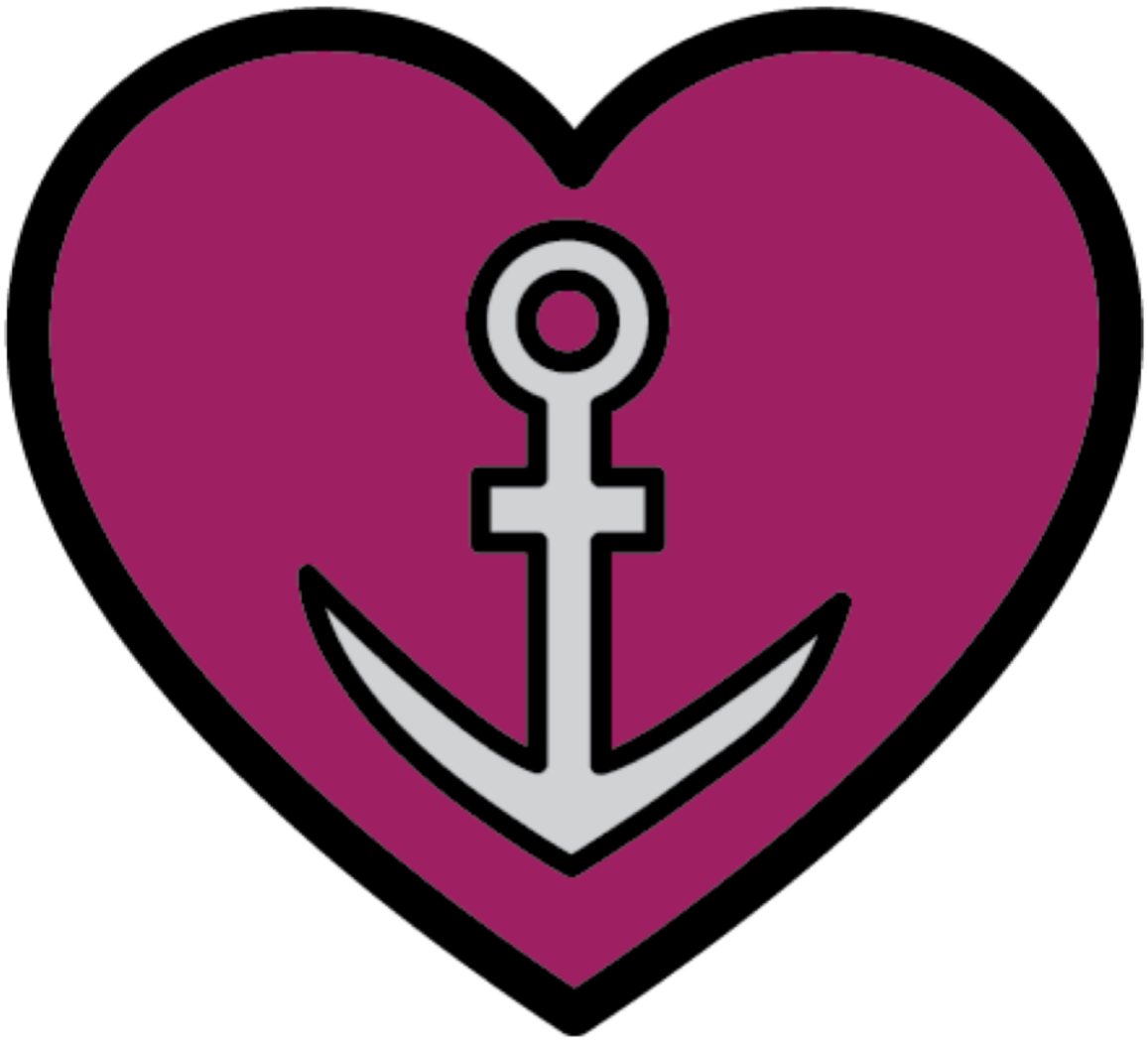

The virtue by which we love God above all things, and our neighbors as ourselves.

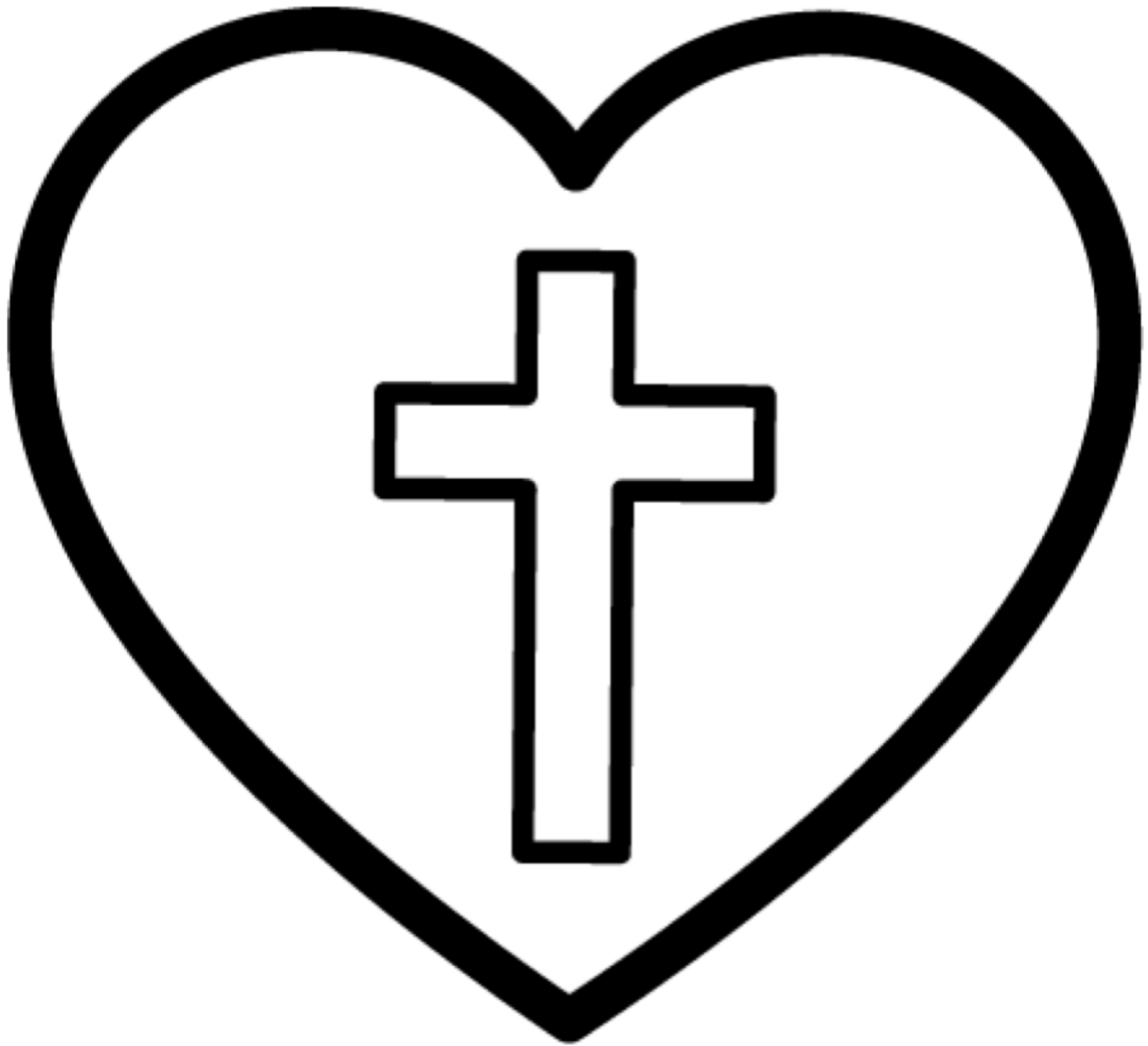
Virtues in Action

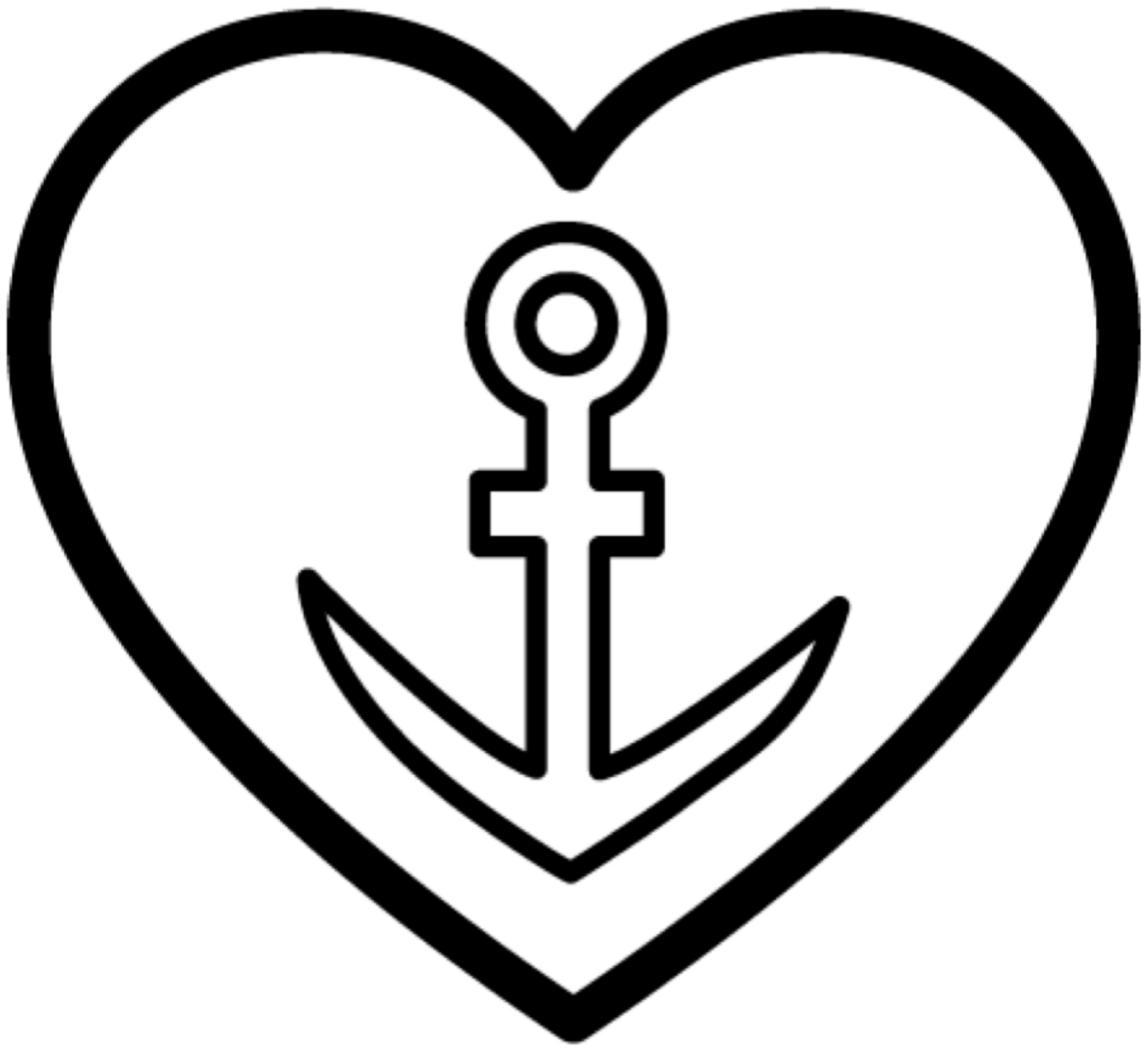


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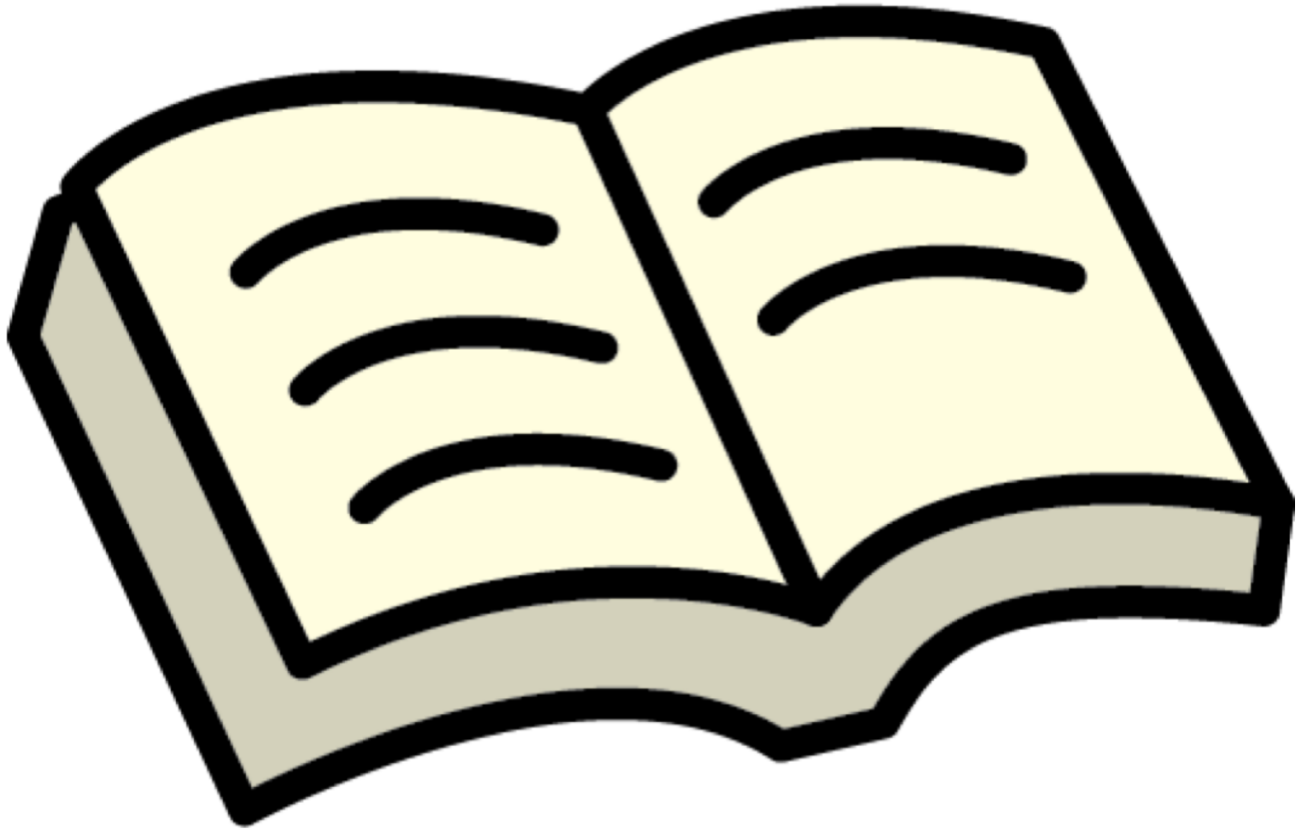

PRUDENCE



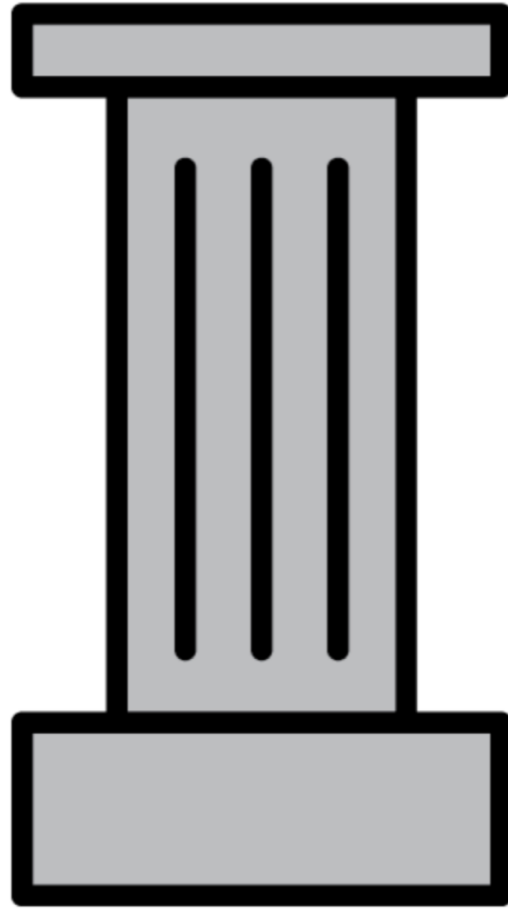
The virtue that allows us to make right decisions. It helps us slow down in our decision making and pray for guidance.

JUSTICE



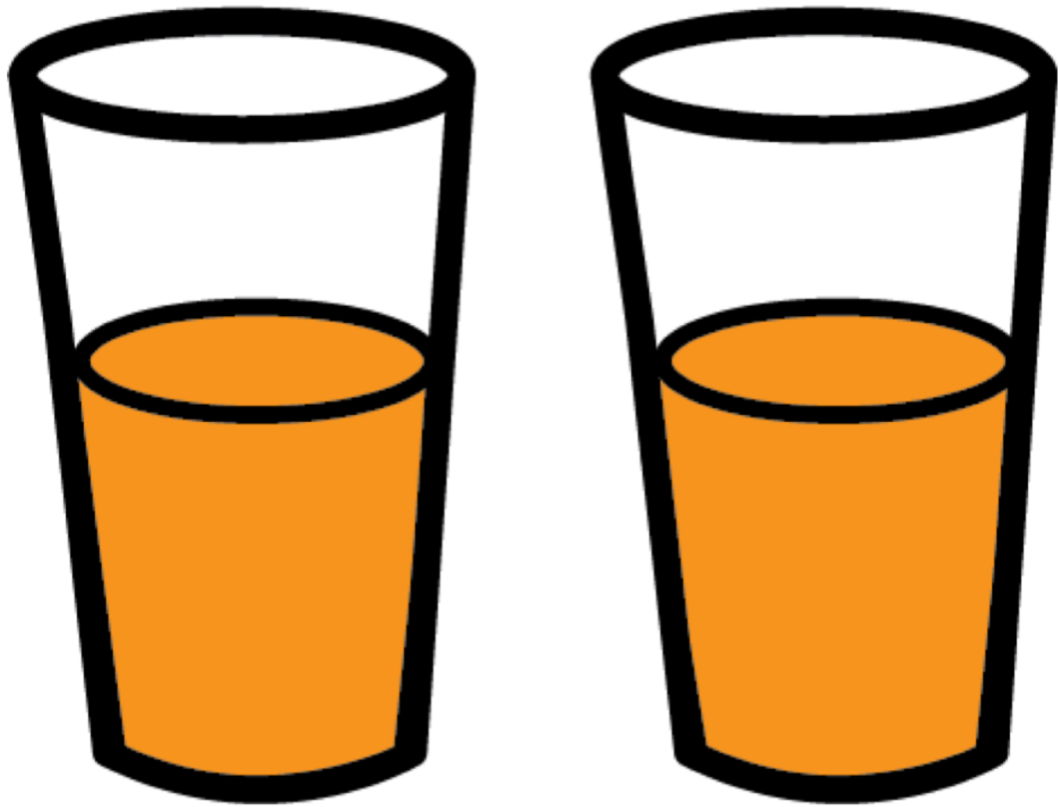
The virtue that gives us the strong desire to give God and others what is due to them by praising God and treating our neighbors with dignity.

ST. JOSEPHINE BAKHITA

St. Josephine Bakhita was kidnapped and sold into slavery at age seven in her home country of Sudan. She was treated extremely poorly by her enslavers until she was sold to an Italian family. They introduced her to the Catholic faith, which she dedicated her life to. She is now the patron saint of victims of human trafficking.

ST. THOMAS MORE

St. Thomas More was dedicated to this faith. He was also a member of British Parliament and worked with King Henry VIII. However, St. Thomas More remained faithful to the Catholic faith and was sentenced to death for going against the king.



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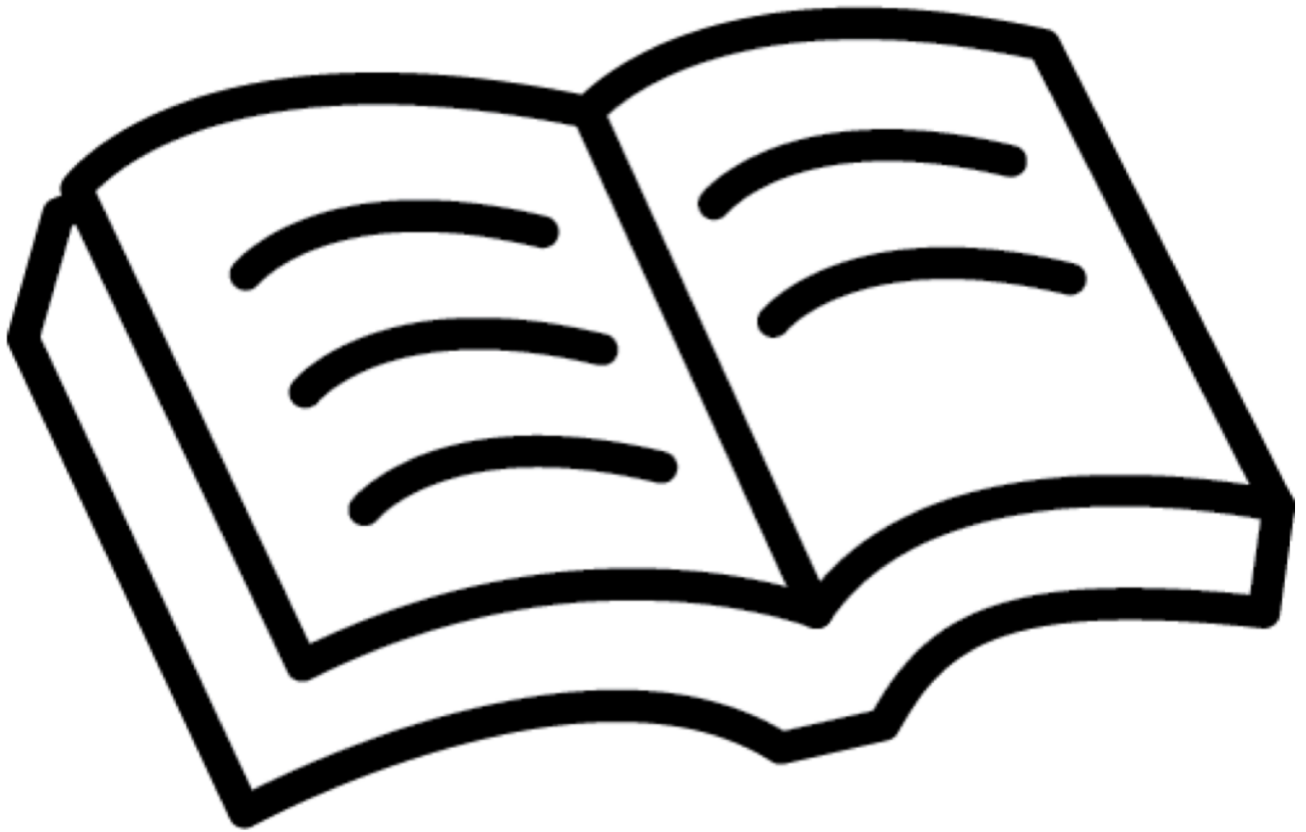
Virtues in Action

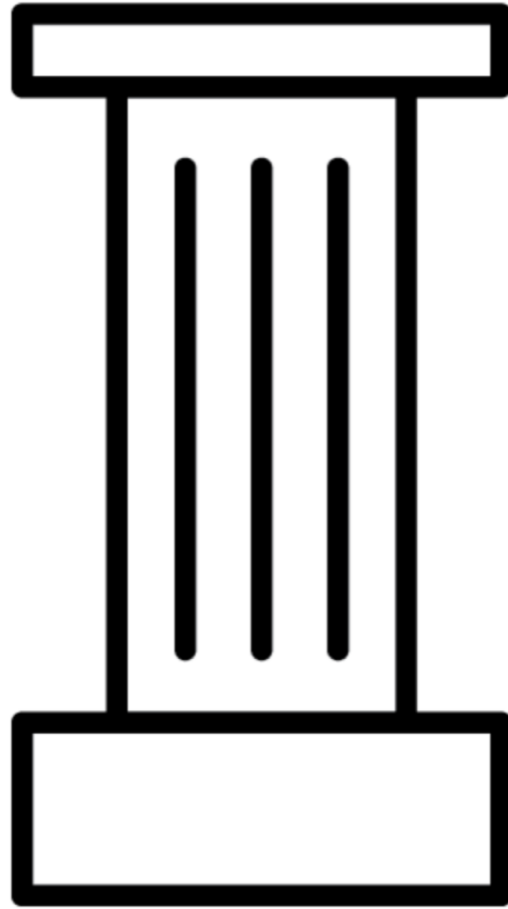
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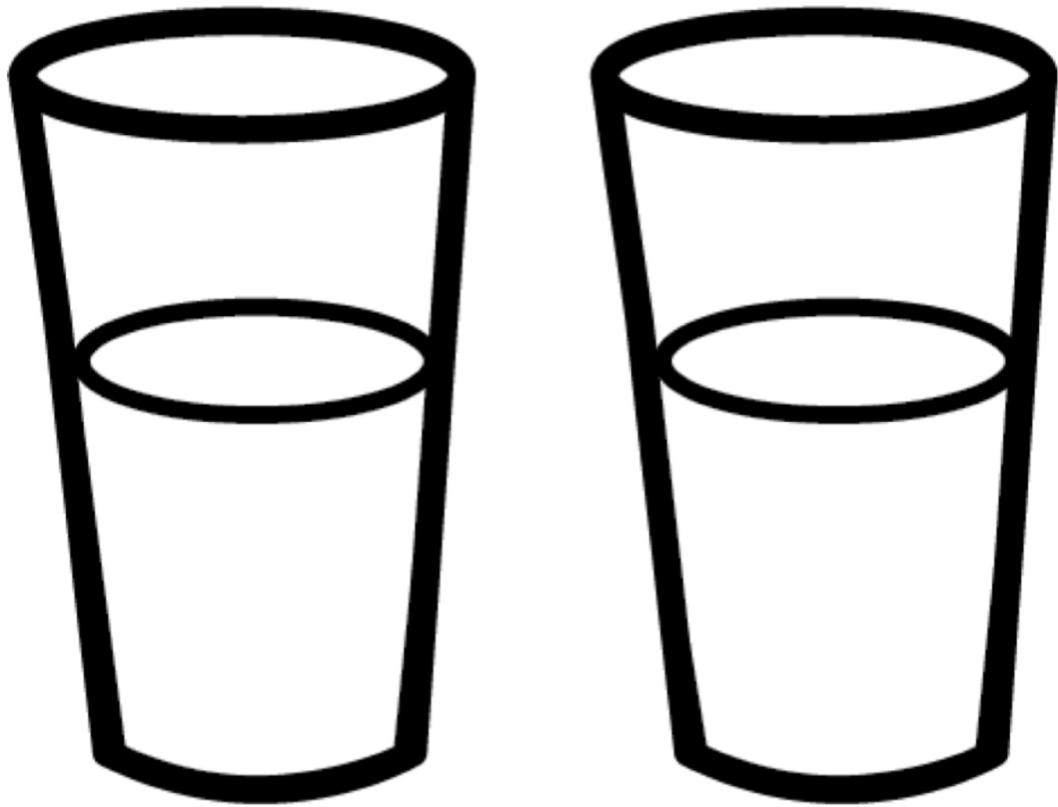
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
